General Comments:

- 04/2013, BLM issued a Notice of Temporary Suspension for all the Gold Hill Mine and Mill operations. Mining or milling operations may not occur until the BLM receives a completed Plan of Operations from the operator and a NEPA analysis (ROD) is approved. Only then will BLM terminate the suspension order and mining/milling operations can continue.
- According to CDRMS records the site has been inactive since 2008 and the Temporary Cessation (TC) has now expired (06/2018). An amendment was received by CDRMS on 12/19/2017 for the Gold Hill Mill, but it did not include the Mine. An adequacy review was sent out on 01/04/2018. CDRMS are waiting response from the operator.
- A monitoring water well (MW-1) is used to quarterly sample water released/discharged from the Mount Royale No. 1 portal/adit. Monitoring includes: Base Metals (As, Cd, Mn, Zn), Sulfate, pH, Temp., hydraulic Conductivity and TDS.

• The sediment pond was partially full of water and was being fed by water discharge from the portal opening. Ankle deep water surrounded the portal entrance. The water was clear with no evidence of iron dissolution. The CDPHE has determined the settling pond does not require a discharge permit for water discharging from the Mine portal into the pond.
