OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted in response to the succession of operator request (SO-1) that was approved on July 12, 2018. The inspection was conducted by Amy Yeldell of the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division). The C Road Pit is a 112c permitted site that includes a total of 84.90 permitted acres. The site located at the intersection of C Road and 31 Road in Grand Junction, CO. No representative from Kilgore Companies LLC dba Elam Construction was present for the inspection

The site was active at the time of the inspection. Four feet of overburden had been stripped and approximately a 300 LF highwall existed. The highwall was near vertical and 15-20 feet tall. The area stripped has not increased since the previous inspection this spring. However the mined highwall and pit floor area has increased. Topsoil and overburden were stored to the east of the active pit area. A conveyor and crusher were on site within the pit floor area. No fuel or permanent structures are on site.

There were lots of annual weeds present in the stripped area. Specifically large amounts of Kochia, Field bindweed and Russian Thistle. The plants had begun to wilt but there was no evidence of dye. The Division cannot tell if these plants were stressed from a weed treatments or the summer heat/drought. When possible theses noxious weeds should be managed to avoid creating a seed bank on site. No interim or final reclamation has been complete. The topsoil pile did not appear to be reseeded yet. If topsoil will not be reapplied for final reclamation this fall then it should be reseeded per Rule 3.1.9(1)

The Division currently requires a financial warranty amount of \$241,201.40 for this site.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
