RE: Revised Incompleteness Notice; 112c Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Amendment Application Package for AM06; Morrison Quarry, File No. M-1973-021

Dear Mr. Deuto,

On September 6, 2018 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (DRMS) received your 112c Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Amendment Application (AM06) binder of exhibits for the Morrison Quarry, File No. M-1973-021. The DRMS received the required application form on September 11, 2018. I left you a voice message on September 17 to discuss additional information needed by the DRMS, but have not heard back from you. A review of the information received determined that the following items must be received before the Division can consider your application as being submitted and technical review can begin:

APPLICATION FORM

- 1. <u>P. 4, Item 13.1.</u> The application requires a list of designated chemicals or acid-producing materials to be used or stored on site. The question was left blank. If there are no such materials of chemicals to be used or stored on site, please indicate "none", otherwise please list these items.
- **2.** <u>Pp. 5 6, Responsibilities as a Permittee.</u> There are 10 paragraphs requiring the Permittees initials. All were left blank. These must be submitted before the DRMS can begin review of the amendment application.

EXHIBITS

3. <u>Rule 6.4.18 Exhibit R - Proof of Filing with County Clerk and Recorder</u>. The Exhibit R text indicates the application was sent to the "Town of Morrison Clerk and Recorder". The requirement is to place the application with the local <u>county</u> (Jefferson in this case) clerk and recorder. The attached affidavit includes the address for the Jefferson County Clerk and Recorder, but no other indication is included as to where the application was actually placed. Please confirm the application was placed with the Jefferson County Clerk and Recorder.

Your 112c Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Amendment Application will not be considered submitted/filed until the information listed above is received and found sufficient to begin our review. A decision date will be established 90 days from the date of receipt and acceptance of all of the requested information.



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Pursuant to Rule 1.4.1(8), you have sixty (60) days from the date of this letter to submit all necessary documents that the Division needs for an application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the sixty day period, the application has not been determined to be filed with the Division, the Division shall deny the application and terminate the application file.

The response to this Incompleteness Notice is due on or before November 20, 2018.

This letter shall not be interpreted to mean that there are no other completeness issues or technical deficiencies in your application. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
