RE: Sheehan Pit, Permit No. M-2007-058, Inspection Problem Abated

Dear Mr. Corson:

On July 10, 2018 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) conducted an inspection of the above referenced site. Problem 1) Acid and toxic materials was cited as a problem for having fuel stored on site outside of a secondary containment structure. The current mining plan does not allow for fuel storage on site. Problem 2) Support facilities on-site was cited as a problem for having buildings on site in contrary to the mining plan which explicitly states no support facilities will exist.

Corrective actions required you submit a technical revision to the mining plan to allow for fuel storage on site and support facilities by the corrective action date. Alternatively the buildings and fuel may be removed in lieu of a technical revision.

On September 21, 2018 the Division received photos that the fuel tank was being removed from site. Additionally the Division received a technical revision request to the mining plan which allowed for both structures and fuel storage. This satisfies the corrective action and it is considered abated.
