Subject: New Elk Mine (Permit No. C-1981-012) TR-73 Review of proposed reduction to the water monitoring plan

New Elk Company have proposed reduced monitoring of groundwater wells at the New Elk mine while the mine remains inactive. I have the following comments.

- Minor changes should be made to the proposed language used in the footnote to Table 27, and in the text of pages 109 and 109a. Specifically: Monitoring of the wells is suspended while the mine remains inactive, but the full monitoring program will be resumed prior to any resumption of mining.
- 2. NE-1-10 (which is completed in the Allen seam, approximately 1000' from existing mine workings, down the projected potentiometric gradient) should be excluded from the reduced monitoring requirements; historic data from the well should be included in the AHR together with data from the current monitoring period.
- 3. The currently approved groundwater monitoring program at the New Elk mine is limited in terms of its scope; for example there are no identified groundwater points of compliance within the permit area, nor are there any upgradient bedrock monitoring wells. I am not in a position to make any further recommendations at this time, since I have not thoroughly evaluated the monitoring program during the preparation of this memo.
