Dear Mr. Schuler,

On October 10, 2018, the Division received via email photographic documentation of the Russian olive trees having been removed from your pit floor, thereby addressing Problem No. 3 cited in the inspection report dated August 16, 2017. During a follow-up inspection on April 10, 2018, the Division noted Problem No. 1 cited in the August 16, 2017 inspection report had been resolved as well, and noted it in the inspection report for that site visit dated August 31, 2018.

The Division considers the corrective actions (reference Problem Nos. 1 and 3) resolved. The Division anticipates receiving additional photographic evidence of having flattened and stabilized the pit slopes (reference Problem No. 2) before the end of the 2018 construction season.
