## **Additional Actions Necessary**

Non-Compliance Issues to be addressed by Operator

1.b. In process of moving previously noted dirt piles on west end. A lot has been moved and some areas better sloped. However, this is not complete, pending pond construction first.

2.a. Non-compliant. Ref. 1.b.i. & 1.b.ii.

2.b. \*No stormwater controls are currently in place at the site. This needs to be done in accordance with the applicable stormwater management plan and State of CO issued permit. It isn't clear the status of these items at this time. MATT WASN'T SURE ABOUT THIS AND WILL CHECK INTO IT. 2.d. \*Operations and interim management require monitoring and treatment of invasive plants (defined as plants that are not part of the original plant community that have the potential to come a dominant species at the site if not controlled). NOTHING DONE YET AT THIS POINT. 2.e. Non-compliant. Ref. 1.b.i. & 1.b.ii.

3.a. Non-compliant. \*A 55 gallon bunghole HDPE drum in the center of the water storage containers in the SE corner of the permit boundary still does not appear to be labeled in accordance with OSHA regulations. MATT SAID IT WILL BE USED FOR TRASH AND THE TOP WILL EVENTUALLY BE CUTOFF. BLM NOTED THAT IT STILL NEEDS TO BE LABELED AT THIS POINT.
3.b. \*Oil stains noted in last inspection could not be checked due to the snow cover. MATT STATED ALL OF THESE WERE DUG UP AND STORED IN A KIDDIE POOL RIGHT NOW, WHICH IS THEIR "SECONDARY CONTAINMENT". Note: BLM did not observe a kiddie pool on site.

4.c. \*Fence still has not bee installed. MATT SAID THAT CONTRACTOR HAS CONSTRUCTION CHAIN LINK FENCE THAT WILL BE PUT UP AROUND ALL OF THE OPERATIONS. THE FENCE SITS ON TOP OF THE GROUND AND SHOULD BE PUT UP BY 10/19. 4.e. Refer to 2.b. Above.

5.a-c. No documentation yet. BLM EXPLAINED TO MATT WHAT THIS WAS, WHAT NEEDED TO BE DONE AND THAT DOCUMENTATION IS REQUIRED.

5.d-e. A majority of permits are in place. Follow-up still needed on the following:

\*Stormwater permit with State of Colorado - associated stormwater management plan, which will address 2.b. And 4.e.

## **Final Notes**

General Comments: Non-compliance items #1-10 that were included with the 07/05/18 BLM non-compliance order and still remain somewhat in non-compliance as of 10/8/18.

#7 Matt stated that the contractor currently working on the dirt work will be putting in the pond. They will go through all the pond liner to see if any of it is salvageable and, if not, it will be disposed of properly. This will be done NLT 10/19.

#8 The dirt work needed that has been noted as a non-compliance item for the past few months has seen some progress. The remaining dirt work needed will be completed NLT 10/19 according to Matt.

#9 The dirt work needed that has been noted as a non-compliance item for the past few months has seen some progress. The remaining dirt work needed will be completed NLT 10/19 according to Matt.

#10 To date, no monitoring/reporting has been submitted to BBLM for the non-operational period. This requirement was again explained to Matt. As of now, operations seem to be starting up again and therefore this will not be a requirement. However, once the seasonal shutdown begins, the requirements for interim management will need to be met.
