Additionally, within Section 36, Township 47 North, Range 16 West of the New Mexico Principal Meridian, a road corridor of 1.08 acres, an area of 1.30 acres encompassing the discharge floare of Pond 001, and an area of 2.31 acres encompassing a portion of the New Horizon Mine 1 Pond 001. In total, the New Horizon North Puritibundary contains 234.78 acres, more or less. The above mentioned tracts of fand are located on USGS 7.5 minute Nucla Quadrangle map.
