I hope this work in an E-mail and if not I can draw up a letter and send it. You can let me know. I'll answer your three questions below

#1. The Name on the mine will be Five Rivers Cattle Feeding LLC. 719-688-8146 will be the contact

#2. If we are allowed to take out the pond and some of the existing and functional structures, that will leave an estimated stock pile of aggregate (65,000 ton) and 35 acres to reseed.

- a. Reseed disturbed areas 35 acres @ 1000 per acre \$35,000
- b. Replace top soil and remove existing stockpile 65,000 ton at .50 \$32, 500
- c. Weed control 8 hours \$1484

Total bond of \$68, 984

#3. To address your last question, We feel that liner and structure certification from Gary Chapman P.E from Enviro-Ag Engineering and the reservoir portions of the bond should be removed.
