The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (Division), received the above referenced application on November 21, 2018. The Division has reviewed the application and found it to be incomplete for the purposes of considering the application "filed". The following items will need to be addressed and submitted in order to make your application complete:

## **Application Form:**

The following items must be corrected on the application form:

- 1.) According to the Colorado Secretary of State, the company name for the applicant is White Wolf Construction and Landscaping, LLC. Item #1 of the application indicates the applicant's name is White Wolf Construction, LLC. Please submit a revised copy of the application with item #1 filled out with the correct company name.
- 2.) Item #2 of the application page was not filled out. Please provide an operation name for the site.
- 3.) Two quarter sections were marked on item number 8 of the application and the quarter/quarter section was not checked. Please fill out the location information with one quarter section marked and one quarter/quarter section marked.

4.) Please provide a location map in accordance with Rule 6.3.1(3).

## Rule 6.3.7, Exhibit G – Source of Legal Right-to-Enter

5.) Please provide the documentation required for your source of legal right-to-enter in accordance with Rule 6.3.7.



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## **Financial Warranty**

6.) Please submit a fully executed financial warranty in the amount of \$2,500 per acre of affected land (a fraction of an acre is counted as one acre for calculation). Please note, during the review period, the Office or Board may require a greater amount necessary to ensure that the estimated costs of reclamation are assured. Several different forms of financial warranties are provided by the Act. Please review Rule 4.3 to determine which type of financial warranty you desire to use. You may obtain the appropriate forms from the Division's Web Page at www.mining.state.co.us..

In accordance with Rule 1.4.1(8), an applicant has sixty (60) days from the date of finding the application incomplete to submit all the necessary documents that the office needs for an application to be considered complete for the purposes of filing.
