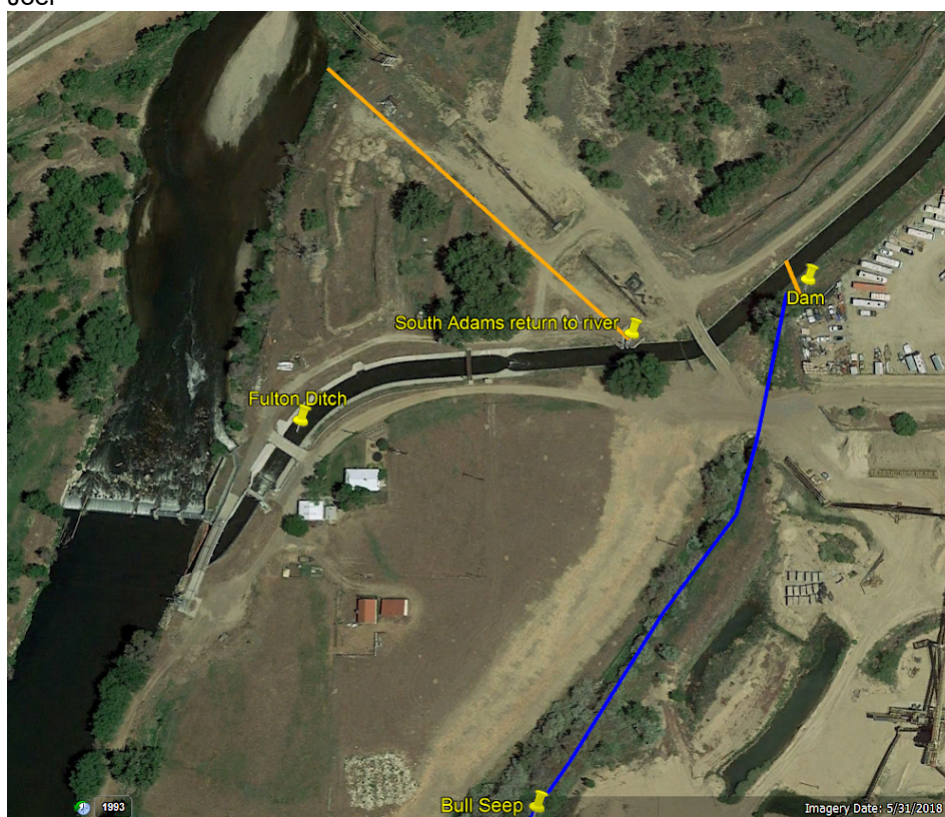

FYI, we placed sandbags in the Fulton Ditch where the Bull Seep dumps into the Fulton Ditch and are forcing the water upstream 200 feet to the South Adams return to the river (with permission from Fulton Ditch and South Adams Water).

This has reduced Bull Seep flow down the Fulton Ditch 90% which reduces flow at the Bull Seep turnout at Hazeltine, reduces flow near Orr property, and reduces the volume we need to pump out of the reservoir. Without this \$100 temporary solution we would have needed to get a second pump. In mid-March, we'll pull out the bags when Fulton Ditch Co closes the Bull Seep turnout.
