A recent internal audit has shown that according to our records, the Division has not received the following:

Even though the due date for submittal of all Annual Fees has passed, the Division is offering a one-time 30-day grace period, effective December 3, 2018 for you to submit the following:

- 2014 Annual Report, Map and Fees (\$86)
- 2015 Annual Report, Map and Fees (\$86)
- 2016 Annual Report, Map and Fees (\$86)
- 2017 Annual Report, Map and Fees (\$86)
- 2018 Annual Report, Map and Fees (\$86)

Effective January 1, 2018, all annual report, map, and fees must be submitted electronically, using the Division's ePermitting system.

Due to the number of past due fees you will have to log into the ePermitting system for each individual year to submit an annual report and associated map. However, for convenience you may log into the ePermitting system and pay the most recent annual fee (2018) then pay the remaining annual fees with a check, via certified mail, payable to:

The above listed Annual Fees must be submitted to the Division no later than 5:00pm on January 2, 2019, or a Notice of Possible Violation, Cease and Desist Order from ALL prospecting related activities, Civil Penalties equal to the amount of the annual fees due, and Notice of Formal Public Hearing before the Mined Land Reclamation Board for consideration of a POSSIBLE PERMIT REVOCATION AND FINANCIAL WARRANTY FORFEITURE will be issued for File No. P-2013-008.
