All,

At 11:00 am on Friday December 28th, approximately 300 gallon's of process water overtopped the Process Ore Thickener Tank's primary containment. Upon discovery, the Process Ore Thickener Tank was bypassed. It's is believed that the root cause of the spill was a malfunctioning level indicator. A sample of the impacted soil has been collected and will be sent off for analysis.
