Dear Mr. Cazier,

It has recently come to our attention that Zephyr Minerals (Zephyr Gold USA Ltd.) has submitted a Modification of Existing NOI for Section 13 in Fremont County (also known as the Dawson Gold Project), CO to the BLM Royal Gorge Field Office.

We would like to express our concerns regarding this particular plan as it appears to directly impact an established recreational trail system – Section 13 – that is part of a larger, well-used trail system. The proposed road construction appears to impact the Hot Shots Trail in two locations. This intrusion into established recreational areas is disconcerting to our organization and to the community at large.

We would like to ask that the Sentinel Road not be allowed within 200 ft of the existing Hot Shots Trail (or any established, extant trail.) Our community has invested a significant amount of sweat equity and financial contributions in order to create, maintain, and promote these recreational opportunities, and their destruction would be counter to the favorable progress that we've made in the way of establishing a sustainable, healthy, positive use for this particular piece of land.
