## EXHIBIT L – PERMANENT MAN-MADE STRUCTURES

There are three small wooden structures located on the Mammoth Millsite MS No. 17576, 4591 Lickskillet Road, Gold Hill, Colorado 80302. The Mammoth Millsite is owned by James K. McCumber and Amy Fortunato, P.O. Box 1927, Boulder, Colorado 80306. There is a single family residence, a storage shed, a small barn, and an unused corral located on the Eureka Millsite MS No. 601B, 4801 Lickskillet Road, Gold Hill, Colorado 80302. The owners of the Eureka Millsite are Gene L. Sapp and Dene F. Sapp. There are also power poles and power lines within 200 feet of the affected area that are owned by Excel Energy, 2655 63<sup>rd</sup> Street, Boulder, Colorado 80301. In addition, Left Hand Canyon Drive, County Road No. 106, and Lickskillet Road, County Road No. 106 are located within 200 feet of the affected area in this location. Sunshine Canyon Drive, County Road No. 52 is also within 200 feet of the affected area. These are owned by Boulder County and maintained and administered by the Boulder County Transportation Department, 2525 13th Street, Boulder, Colorado, 80304.
