Dear Party and/or Interested Person:

The above referenced amendment application was filed with the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) on January 4, 2018. The initial application decision date of February 5, 2018 was extended six times at the request of Colorado Milling Company, LLC (Applicant), to the current decision date of January 4, 2019. Pursuant to Rule 1.4.1(10), the Applicant has the burden of demonstrating the amendment application meets the minimum requirements of the Act, Rules and Regulations. As of the decision date, there were outstanding adequacy issues which had not been resolved to the Division's satisfaction.

Pursuant to Rule 1.4.1(9), the Applicant may request that the Division's review time (for an application) be extended and the decision date reset, not to exceed 365 days from the date the application was filed. For the above referenced application, the current decision date marks 365 days from the date the application was filed. Therefore, the Division is unable to approve any additional extensions, and the matter has been scheduled for consideration by the Mined Land Reclamation Board (Board).

Please be advised, the formal Board hearing for consideration of the Applicant's extension request has been scheduled for the **February 20-21, 2019** Board meeting, which will be held in Room 318 of 1313 Sherman Street, Denver, Colorado, beginning at 9:00 a.m. on February 20th or as soon thereafter as the matter can be considered. Pursuant to Rule 1.4.1(9), at the hearing, the Board may at the request of the applicant extend the review time and decision date, deny the application, or approve the application with or without conditions.
