Mr. Beck,

As long as all information required under the application as well as our Rules and Regulations have been provided and found acceptable by the Division, a permit for coal mining can be granted. The reclamation bond is posted by the mining company (or permittee) and must be posted before any disturbance can occur. The following link is to the Colorado's coal mining Rules and Regulations which is referenced by our initial incompleteness letter that is attached.
