Notice of Incomplete Final Release Request, SL-1**

Dear Ms. Schreiber:

On January 4, 2019, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your request for full/final release of the entire permitted area at the LA Methodist Pit, Permit No. M-1995-008. We have determined that the following information must be submitted to complete the requirements stated in the Request for Full or Partial Release of Permit Area form, and the requirements of Rule 4.17 of the Hard Rock, Metal, and Designated Mining Operations Rules and Regulations:

- 4.17.1(2) The Operator shall include in the notice to the Office the names and addresses and phone numbers of all owners of record to the affected land. *There appears to be some omissions here:*
 - i. *Only Fremont Paving and Redi-Mix is listed and no address is given on p. 2;*
 - ii. *A search of Fremont County Assessor's properties indicates the City of Florence owns a thin portion on the east side (essentially the north-south access road (see enclosed Figure 1);*

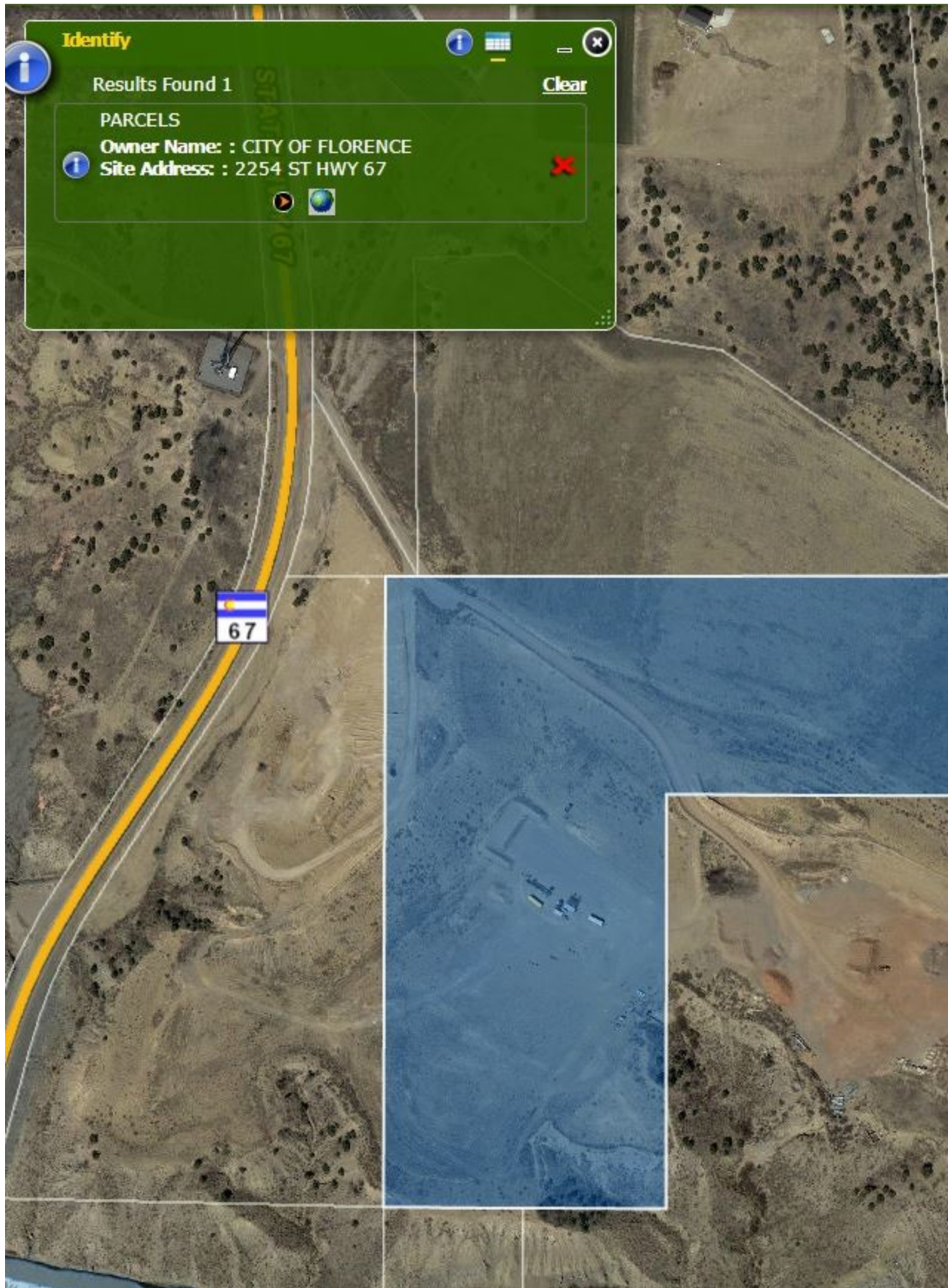


Figure 2. MacKenzie Ranch LLLP Property

 - iii. *A search of Fremont County Assessor's properties indicates MacKenzie Ranch LLLP owns the northern "triangle" between Hwy 67 and the access road (see enclosed Figure 2).*

Please clarify and/or correct these deficiencies, providing additional names, addresses and phone numbers as appropriate.
