On January 16, 2019, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received your request to extend the decision date for the 110(1) Limited Impact Operation Reclamation Permit Application for the Project P.J., File No. M-2018-007. The Division hereby approves the extension request and the decision date has been set for **April 3, 2019**.

In accordance with Rule 1.4.1(9), applicants may request that the Office's review time be extended not to exceed 365 days from the date the application was filed. Please note, as the Project P.J. application was called complete and considered filed on April 3, 2018, the decision date cannot be extended again. If there remain adequacy issues after 365 days, the Office may deny the application or set the matter for a Board hearing.

The Division requests the Applicant provide all adequacy responses no later than March 4, 2019, to allow sufficient time to review your adequacy review responses.
