Dear Mr. Raglin,

On January 23, 2019, the Mined Land Reclamation Board approved your Notice of Temporary Cessation of the Providence Mine. The first period of Temporary Cessation began on July 5, 2018, and will last up to five years, ending July 5, 2023.

Please be aware that you must continue to meet the performance standards of Rule 3.1 in order to maintain the mine in a non-producing or non-development state. Additionally, while in Temporary Cessation, you must continue to comply with the Rules and Act, including filing of Annual Reports and Annual Fees.

Although prior notice is not required, you must provide a written notice to the Division no later than 30 days <u>after</u> re-activation of the mine.
