
RE: Annual Fees and Report

Greetings,

Weed spraying was completed on June 1st with small concentrations along back sloped areas. Previous year high concentration in the low area north of the drainage just north of the current mine area show complete removal. Current problem areas are along the southern border area adjacent to the entrance migrating from a neighboring property and along the east pond adjoining neighboring property outside the boundary. With extreme drought conditions growth is stunted and quite obvious to spot.

There has been no new activity. Concentrating of sales to reduce remaining stockpiles will enable room for a plant site and stockpile area with mining of a previous exposed deposit currently under the stockpile area.
