Holcim is formally submitting this request for a **two-month** extension on closing and implementing corrective actions to the final remaining inspection topic cited in your report. Specific reasons for this requested extension are as follows:

Hydrologic Balance (Ponded Water)

Holcim has reached out to the City of Greeley to propose a water lease agreement that would satisfy DWR. Greeley and Holcim and agreed to the terms of a longterm water lease agreement that would guarantee right to up to 10 AF of water per year. The Greeley Water and Sewer Board is set vote on the lease agreement in their quarterly meeting on Wednesday, February 20th.

Assuming the Board agrees, we will be able to draft an augmentation plan for submittal to the Division of Water Resources for review/approval.
