On January 24, 2019 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your emailed response to our January 15, 2019 addendum adequacy letter. The Division has reviewed your responses and approved the Technical Revision addendum to TR-100 addressing the following:

VLF2 Liner Inspection - unsupported material north of the mill platform (Mill Surge Pile)

The terms of the Technical Revision No. 100 approved by the Division are hereby incorporated into Permit No. M-1980-244. All other conditions and requirements of Permit No. M-1980-244 remain in full force and effect. The Division has reviewed the change associated with the TR-100 addendum for impacts to the financial warranty and has determined that this change does not require an increase to the current reclamation liability.

The condition VLF 2 liner in underlying the Mill Surge Pile was determined to be in compliance with the approved specifications. The Certification is accepted by the Division pursuant to Rule 7.3.2 of the Mineral Rules and Regulations of The Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board for Hard Rock, Metal, and Designated Mining Operations. CC&V may commence loading ore on this portion of the liner.
