



Areas regraded and vegetated by Boulder County Open Space with Grant Money as part of the St. Vrain Restoration Project (5.5 ac)

- 1 Plant Site – 5 acres  
Waiting on Boulder County District Court decision before we can prepare site to begin mining again. (septic, building permits, etc.)
- 2 Sediment deposited by St. Vrain Creek from Breach 1 from the 2013 flood - 8.99 acres\*
- 3 Sediment deposited by St. Vrain Creek from Breach 2 from the 2013 flood - 10.5 acres\*
- 4 Sediment deposited by St. Vrain Creek from Breach 2. Boulder County Parks and Open Space working with FEMA to reestablish water storage reservoir and remove sediment – 9.99 acres

\*MM intends to re-mine to re-establish prior reclamation, Boulder County would like for it to remain as-is. Discussions will continue thru 2019.
