Hi, Nick

I have some more questions and comments on Table 3 and mapping. This time for the West Portal area, the 2011 disturbance areas, and the other areas (Golden Eagle and the Jansen Loadout).

1. In the map legend there is an item that is "Ten Years (or more)". Perhaps this should be "Pre 2003" instead. This is applicable to the East Portal map too.
2. Area 42 and Area 65 are both "Powder and Cap House." Is that correct?
3. Areas 47 and 63 appear to overlap. Be aware of double counting here. (Avoid that problem in other places as well.)
4. It is unclear where the line is between Areas 52 and 53. And if they are lumped together, the area appears to be smaller than the 3.95 acres in the table. ($0.83 + 3.12 = 3.95$.)
5. Containment #WP-1 (Area 50) has no polygon on map. Also, the line between Area 50 and Area 44 is unclear.
6. The polygon for Containment #WP-2 (Area 45) appears to be in the wrong place on the map.
7. It appears that the polygon for Area 62 needs to be extended to the north to capture all of the storage yard. Please check this.
8. Maps should be provided for the "other areas," namely the former Golden Eagle site (Northwest Airshaft) and the Jansen Loadout.

Again, thanks for addressing these items.
