This is to notify you that Venture Resources is planning to test some dewatering bags on a limited scale inside the lined area of the Hukill Gulch mill-site tailings area. After studying the information and talking to the manufacturers it appears that using dewatering bags on the face of the tailings dam will significantly strengthen the dam. Therefore Venture Resources plans to test dewatering bags on a limited scale. If they work as good as we expect we will submit a TR for approval to use them on the face of the dam.
