On April 2, 2019 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety **approved** the Technical Revision application submitted to the Division on March 12, 2019. The revision was to address the following changes:

- Mining activities have completed and the site has entered final reclamation. All stockpiled material left on site are approved to stay post-reclamation for ranch use only. The plan also updates the reclamation plan. No further dirt work is required, only minor demolition and revegetation work remain.

The terms of the Technical Revision No. 1 approved by the Division are hereby incorporated into Permit No. M-2011-026. All other conditions and requirements of Permit No. M-2011-026 remain in full force and effect.

The approval of this Technical Revision satisfies the required corrective actions outlined in the Inspection Report dated December 4, 2018. Due to weather conditions the only remaining corrective actions is the general site cleanup and installation of proper secondary containment devices for all hazardous materials. When conditions allow please provide photo documentation that compliance has been achieved.
