Dear Mr. Raglin and Ms. Dehlin:

The Teller County Planning Department has completed its review of the Newmont Mining Corporation's (CC&V) Technical Revision TR # 112 – Power Pole Installation.

- 1. Teller County understands that the Newmont Mining Corporation CC&V is proposing the additional power poles in order to improve the fiber optic capability available to its mining operation. If approved, this addition will lead to better and more reliable communications within the Newmont Corporation's Cresson Project mining operation.
- 2. It is also understood that in addition to improved communications, safety will be enhanced by the improved fiber optic capability with regards to mining operations.
- 3. The four proposed poles as depicted in the included figure one (1) will extend the current fiber optic line from the existing Century Link owned power poles located on the Shelf Road to existing infrastructure at the ADR 2 Plant.
- 4. Teller County has reviewed TR #112 against the standards contained in Appendix A, CCMOD, sections 8.A and 8.B and finds that it is compliant. The dimensional limitations outlined in section 2.g for power poles apply and it is our understanding that they will be the standard 35 foot wooden power poles.

5. Teller County concurs with TR # 112 as written.
