#### **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. A representative for the operator was not present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The Van 4 Shaft is located approximately ten miles west of Naturita and accessed from Dd19 Rd. The site is a 110d operation that includes a total of 8.4 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$75,057.00 for this site. The Division has reviewed the reclamation costs, in order to ensure the financial warranty reflects the actual current cost of fulfilling the requirements of the Reclamation Plan, and determined that the current financial warranty amount is adequate.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted on the hoist building, which is visible from the site entrance.

The permit was amended in 2012 to include an Environmental Protection Plan (EPP). The EPP included an improved stormwater management plan and control structures. The operator completed installation of the stormwater control structures in June 2012. Stormwater control structures appeared to be in good condition during this inspection. The site has been in Temporary Cessation since June 2012. The second five year period of Temporary Cessation began June 13, 2017.

Two metal buildings remain on site, the hoist house and shop. The west wall of the hoist house is falling apart and the building is in disrepair. The west wall of the shop building is falling apart and the building is in disrepair. There is a metal shed behind the shop building that has been knocked over and is falling apart. These issues have been noted as a problem at the beginning of this report. The buildings shall be removed from the site, or repaired in order to control unsightliness and deleterious effects of such refuse.

The shaft is secured with grating welded to the collar, and a welded gate at the base of the headframe. The headframe appears stable.

No other problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
