Notice of Problem / Possible Violation**

Dear Mr. Newlon,

On May 2, 2019 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (DRMS) received a withdrawal request for the Succession of Operator (SO) application submitted to the DRMS on March 4, 2019. As part of the SO review, the DRMS learned the land ownership of the Mitchell Pit has changed and is no longer owned by R E Monks. This is considered a problem. The corrective action and due date is summarized below:

PROBLEM TOPIC: Availability Of Records

PROBLEM /POSSIBLE VIOLATION: Problem: The Permittee is required to provide a description of the basis for legal right of entry to the site and to conduct mining and reclamation (Rule 6.3.7). As a result of the withdrawal of the recent Succession of Operator application, the DRMS has become aware of a change in land ownership.

CORRECTIVE ACTIONS: Provide a description of the basis for legal right of entry to the site and to conduct mining and reclamation. This may be a copy of access lease, deed, abstract of title, or a current tax receipt. A signed statement by the Landowner and acknowledged by a Notary Public stating that the Operator/Applicant has legal right to enter and mine is also acceptable.
