OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. Dale McDermott, representing the Operator, was present during this inspection. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The Tomichi Pit is located approximately 3.2 miles east of Gunnison and accessed from Hwy 50. The site is a 112c operation that includes a total of 134.5 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$269,536.10 for this site. The Division has reviewed the reclamation costs, in order to ensure the financial warranty reflects the actual current cost of fulfilling the requirements of the Reclamation Plan, and determined that the current financial warranty amount is sufficient.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.

The affected area was marked by fencing that was clearly visible and adequate to delineate the affected area boundary.

The site is currently operating in the Stage 1 area, with excavation proceeding from east to west. A processing/plant area is located in the southeast part of the permit area. Materials stockpiles are located on the east side of the plant area. Wash ponds are located on the west side of the plant area. Pond slopes appear stable with no seepage noted.

The scale and scalehouse are located near the entrance to the site. Fuel is stored near the scalehouse in a double walled tank.

Overall, the site is well maintained and orderly. No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
