Re: TR Extension Request, for Pueblo West (M1977-573) from May 30, 2019 to July 15, 2019

Continental Materials Corp. submitted a TR to modify the Reclamation Plan for the Pueblo West Pit, File No. M1977-573. Part of the modification to the Reclamation Plan was to address the Finger Lake area. This area is owned by the Colorado Division of Parks and Wildlife (CDPW). We have not yet been able to schedule a site visit with the CDPW. They requested a site visit, once the site was in Spring/Summer growth, so they could see if any remedial reclamation activities are needed.

Once they inspect the Finger Lake area and have their comments, we will be able to decide if the Finger Lake area may be released or if it needs further attention. Once we have their comments we will be able to submit the revised reclamation plan TR to address the Finger Lake area and re rest of the site.

In addition, if work is needed on the Finger Lake area we may need an access agreement to enter the site and perform any necessary remedial reclamation. We assume the DRMS may want to have the access agreement as part of the TR?
