Dear Mr. Doose:

The Division received the required materials as outlined in the Notice of Filing Deficiencies and on June 18, 2019 deemed your 110(1) Hard Rock Reclamation Permit application for the Von Doose Mine, which is located in Ouray County complete and filed. All comment and review periods began on June 18, 2019. Pursuant to C.R.S. 34-32-115(2) and Hard Rock and Metals Mining Rule 1.4.1(7) your application has been deemed complex and the review period has been extended by sixty (60) days. The current decision date for your application is set at Friday August 16, 2019.

Within ten (10) days you must publish notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the locality of the proposed mining operation. Immediately after the publication, mail a copy of the notice to all owners of record of surface rights and mineral rights, holders of any recorded easements, and all owners of record of lands that are within 200 feet of the boundary of the affected land. Proof of notice and mailings, such as Certified Mail - Return Receipt Requested, must be submitted to the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety prior to the decision date.

The Division is reviewing your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act. We will contact you if additional information is needed. Additionally any changes or additions to the application on file in our office must also be reflected in the public review copy which has been placed with the Ouray County Clerk and Recorder.

Please be reminded that all operators must contact the Colorado Department of Health, Water Quality Control Division regarding storm water permits.
