**INSPECTION TOPIC:** Signs & Markers

**PROBLEM/POSSIBLE VIOLATION:** Problem: An adequate mine identification sign was not posted at the entrance of the mine site. This is a problem for failure to post a mine identification sign as required by Section 3.1.12(1) of the rule.

**CORRECTIVE ACTIONS:** The operator shall, at the entrance of the mine site, post a sign which shall be clearly visible from the access road with the following: the name of the operator, a statement that a reclamation permit for the operation has been issued by the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board; and the permit number. The operator shall submit photo documentation that a proper sign has been posted by the corrective action date.

### **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. A representative for the operator was not present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The Russell Ranch Pit is located approximately three miles southeast of Meeker and accessed from CR79. The site is a 110c operation that includes a total of 9.9 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$47,400.00 for this site. The Division has reviewed the reclamation costs, in order to ensure the financial warranty reflects the actual current cost of fulfilling the requirements of the Reclamation Plan, and determined that the current financial warranty amount is sufficient.

Adequate mine identification signage was not noted at the entrance to the site. This has been noted as a problem. The operator shall post a sign at the entrance to the site that includes the name of the operation and the permit number, in accordance with the requirements of Rule 3.1.12(1).

The affected area was marked by posts that were clearly visible and adequate to delineate the affected area boundary.

Nearly the entire permit area has been disturbed by the operation. Highwalls roughly 20-30 feet in height and 1H:1V slope surround the pit. Materials stockpiles are located throughout the pit. The topsoil stockpile located in northeast part of the pit appeared stable. A scale and scalehouse are located in the processing area in the southeast part of the pit.

Concerns related to stability or erosion were not noted during this inspection. Noxious weed infestations were not noted.

Except for those noted on the first page of this report, no other problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
