Mr. Priola,

DRMS' jurisdiction is limited to enforcing the mining and reclamation plan approved in accordance with permit number M-2007-087 and the Act and Rules that govern construction materials mining/reclamation. DRMS is required to insure mine sites are reclaimed in accordance with the reclamation plan which includes topsoiling and seeding the affected land if the proper zoning was not obtained for the site. If leaving a graveled surface conforms to the zoning requirements with Adam's County, the Division may entertain a revision to the reclamation plan to allow for this, but it is my understanding that this would not conform to the A1 zoning requirements.
