On June 26, 2019 the Mined Land Reclamation Board **approved** the Temporary Cessation application via Consent Agenda. The request was submitted to the Division on April 25, 2019, addressing the following:

- Change of status to the first period of Temporary Cessation (TC) requested, Effective start date 5/1/2019, Expires, 5/1/2024 as well as suspending the Water Quality Monitoring Program while in TC.

The terms of the Temporary Cessation No. 1 approved by the Division are hereby incorporated into Permit No. M-1981-185. All other conditions and requirements of Permit No. M-1981-185 remain in full force and effect. Please note that prior to activation the Division will require two consecutive quarters of water quality monitoring be submitted.
