- 1) CMC would appreciate being provided with a written statement from the DRMS of all of the outstanding adequacy issues that have been identified by the Division regarding the Application for an Amendment to the Gold Hill Mill Limited Impact 110 (2) Permit No. M-1994-117.
- 2) CMC requests that the DRMS review CMC's June 24, 2019 Response Letter to the 4<sup>th</sup> Adequacy Review Letter dated May 21, 2019. It will be helpful if the Division would identify the specific responses that require a more complete response from the operator.
- 3) CMC has hand delivered Gabriel Benvenuti, the DRMS's Financial Assurance Specialist with its check numbered 1286 in the amount of \$21,346.00, made payable to the Mined Land Reclamation Board.
