

Notes: Please refer to the 2018-19 Annual Report Map for the location of areas discussed below. Albert Frei & Sons purchased this mine on June 1, 2017 and renamed the mine AFS - Bennett Pit. An amendment application was filed on 2/13/19 to expand the mine. The decision date was July 26 and the MLRB hearing, if needed is August 21.

8. The total disturbance at the mine is 33.6 acres \pm . Mining continued on the working face that stretches from east to west on the southern part of the mine site. Mining continues on areas previously disturbed by lowering the mine floor and working into the mine face on the north end and mining the stripped area on the south. The following list outlines the various areas of disturbance at the mine in 2019

9. No new area was affected but the slope areas on the north were mined this year.

10. No new area was reclaimed. There are large piles of overburden/sloping material stored on the mine floor adjacent to the area that will need final sloping along the west side. The piles are not located on the map as they are moved as needed to complete the slopes. We will continue to backfill along the west slope area until sloping is complete.

11. Mining will continue on the mine floor and on the working face progressing to the south and east. Depending on the demand for material we may open another 5 acres or more.

12. No reclamation is required at this time.

18. Current Bond Amount \$110,860.00. The bond increased by the Division in September 2018.
