OBSERVATIONS

This was a routine monitoring inspection for the Climax Mine, a 112d-3 Hardrock Mine operated by the Climax Molybdenum Company. The inspection was conducted by DRMS representatives Dustin Czapla, Travis Marshall and Russ Means. Climax representatives, Ray Lazuk, Diana Kelts and James Haag, guided DRMS during the inspection.

This was not a focused inspection, but rather a site tour conducted in order to familiarize DRMS senior staff with the site. The inspection began with a tour of the mill facility. No problems or violations were noted in the mill. The inspection then proceeded to the pit overlook point located on the south side of the pit. Mining was occurring in the pit. No problems or violations were noted in the pit area. We next visited the McNulty OSF and expansion area. Contractors were in the expansion area constructing the access road. No problems or violations were noted in the OSF area. The inspection then proceeded to the facilities on the west side of Hwy 91. The tailings dams were observed along with the Lake Irwin wetlands mitigation project. No problems or violations were noted.
