CONDITIONS FOR APPROVAL

The proposed operation does not anticipate exposing groundwater. Therefore, exposure of ground water must not occur during or after mining operations.

The applicant has indicated that this is a CDOT roadway project and the excavated material will be used as borrow material. The project is expected to be completed within 18 months. The applicant has indicated plans to use water for dust control purposes at the permit site. The source of water for this use has been identified as the Town of Johnstown("Johnstown"). Applicant must provide evidence of a lease water agreement with Johnstown, to ensure water is available for dust control purpose at the site.

COMMENTS: If stormwater runoff is intercepted by this operation and is not diverted or captured in priority, it must be released to the stream system within 72 hours. This may require a discharge permit from CDPHE-WQCD. Otherwise, the operator will need to make replacements for evaporation.
