On behalf of my client L.G. Everist, Inc., I am providing the information we discussed on the telephone on July 29th, 2019 and responds to the US Army Corps of Engineers letter and the History Colorado comment letters in the file.

Enclosed is a copy of the approved Substitute Water Supply Plan (SWSP) that L.G. Everist, Inc. has for the Firestone Pit. This is a combined plan that includes other mines. It has an expiration date of December 31, 2019. It will be revised and renewed prior to the expiration date.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

PERMANENT MAN-MADE STRUCTURES (RULE 6.4.19)

L.G. Everist, Inc., mailed 9 structure agreements on 5/22/19 to any owners of structures on or within 200 feet of the permit area that have not responded in the past. To date we have had 2 returned and an E-mail from Tri-State Power stating they have no problem with the permit, copies attached. If we receive additional signed agreements, we will provide them to the Division for inclusion in the file.
