OBSERVATIONS

The Red Mountain Exploration Drilling NOI was inspected by Peter Hays and Stephanie Mitchell with the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) as part of the Division's monitoring inspection program. Aaron Hilshorst and Alex Ungers with Climax Molybdenum - Henderson Operations (Henderson) were present during the inspection.

The second NOI modification (MD-02) for the site was approved by the Division on February 14, 2017. The modification extended the NOI completion date until December 31, 2018, relocated drill pad #3, stated drill pads #6 and #7 were not utilized and updated the access road location between drill pads #7 and #8.

Drill pads #1-5 were not observed due to boulders on the road preventing access to the drill pads. The Prospector reported no changes to the pads have occurred since the last inspection in 2018. The drill pads are scheduled to be re-contoured in 2020. Drill pads #6-8 were not observed due to a large fallen tree blocking the road south of drill pad #5 preventing access to the drill pads. The Prospector reported drill pads #6-8 were re-contoured in 2018.
