Dear Mrs. Richardson and Mr. Kozimor,

On August 6, 2019 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received a request for a 30 day extension to the Decision date for the Application for Transfer of Minerals Permit and Succession of Operator SO-02. This request was made to finalize the financial warranty. The extension also requested that the amount of the required financial warranty be recalculated. At this time that cannot be done, in order to recalculate the financial warranty a Technical Revision would be required to alter the mining plan which must be submitted by the Permittee, Consolidated Constructors.

In order to accomplish this, SO-02 would need to be withdrawn and a Technical Revision submitted by the Operator. Once approved and the warranty was recalculated a new application for Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operator would be required.

The Division is **approving** the request for the 30 day extension to the decision date for the above listed Succession of Operator. The full amount of the required financial warranty must be submitted by the new decision date Friday, September 6, 2019.
