OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. A representative for the operator was not present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The BLM/West End Pit is located approximately 1.5 miles northwest of Naturita and accessed from DD Road. The site is a 112c operation that includes a total of 149.4 permitted acres. Pursuant to C.R.S. 34-32.5-117(3)(f)(VIII) a financial warranty is not required for this site because the operator is a unit of a county government.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.

The affected area was marked by fencing and posts that were clearly visible and adequate to delineate the affected area boundary.

The site is active. The Phase 1 area has been mined out and is in reclamation. Boulders have been placed along the north side of the reclaimed area in order to keep equipment off. The reclamation area looks good. Grading is adequate and vegetation is becoming well established.

Mining is progressing to the north and east. A near vertical highwall exists at the north and east sides of the pit. The highwall is approximately twenty feet high. Materials stockpiles are located throughout the pit floor. Equipment is stored at the west end of the pit. No fuels are stored on site.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
