OBSERVATIONS

This was a surety-release inspection. The Division received a request for release from further reclamation responsibility from the operator on July 25, 2019. The operator drilled only one of the holes authorized under the NOI. The drill location is located approximately seventeen miles south of Gateway and accessed from O14 Road. This inspection confirmed that reclamation is adequate. The bore hole has been backfilled, the site regraded and seeded. Vegetation is well established. The drill location is nearly indiscernible from the surrounding area.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection. The site is ready to be released.
