On September 3, 2019, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received a copy of the Publisher's Affidavit verifying publication of your notice in the local newspaper for four consecutive weeks for Amendment Application 01 (AM-01) for the Caldwell-Nesselhuf Pit No. 1, Permit No. M-1997-071. The letter did contain a copy of the publication. It was determined, during a review of the publication, that there was an error. The Division reserves the right to further supplement this document with additional adequacy issues and details as necessary.
