**Re: Pikeview Quarry, Permit No. M-1977-211, Incompleteness Notice;
Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Amendment Application Package, AM - 4**

Dear Mr. Schnabel:

On August 26, 2019, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received your 112 Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Amendment Application package for the Pikeview Quarry, Permit No. M-1977-211. Preliminary review of the information received determined that the following items must be received before the Division can consider your application as being submitted and technical review can begin:

APPLICATION FORM:

- 1) **Page 2, Item 9 – Location Information:** This information is for the “center” of the area where the majority of the mining will occur. Two Section numbers: 9 & 10 are indicated, then the NE quarter section is checked. Township 13 is indicated, but neither the North nor South box is checked. Range 67 is indicated, but neither the East nor West box is checked. Please resubmit page 2 with only one Section number (center of mining); the appropriate North/South Township box checked; and the appropriate East/West Range box checked.
- 2) **Page 6, Responsibilities as a Permittee, Item 10:** Item 10 is for Joint Ventures and requires a power of attorney authorizing the signing representative to sign the application. No such power of attorney document was included in the application. If this is a joint venture, please provide the power of attorney document, otherwise resubmit page 6 with Item 10 left blank.
- 3) **Page 8, Certification:** As the Applicant is a Corporation, the Corporation Attest (Seal) and corporate secretary or equivalent signature is required. Neither of these are included on page 8. Please resubmit page 8 with the corporate secretary (or equivalent) signature and the corporate seal. If no corporate seal exists, please indicate as much.

Your application will not be considered submitted until the information listed above is received and found sufficient to begin our review. A decision date will be established 90 days from the date of receipt of all of the requested information. Additionally, if you have already published notice you will need to republish notice, after the Division considers the application submitted. This notice must be published once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks, starting within ten (10) days of the date your application is considered submitted.





We will notify you when you should initiate republication of your notice. The final date for receiving comments is the 20th day after the fourth publication or the next regular business day.

You have sixty (60) days from the above date to submit all necessary documents that the Office needs for an application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the sixty day period, the application has not been determined to be filed with the Office, the Office shall deny the application and terminate the application file.

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in your application. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
