The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) has completed the initial review of materials submitted by Mountain Coal Company, LLC (MCC) in support of the MR-437 application. The Division's comments and questions are below, with items that need to be addressed highlighted in bold type.

Rule 2.05.3 – Operation Plan – Permit Area

1. The construction proposed with MR-437 implies changes to the operation of the MB-5E pond.

Please review the text of section 2.05.3 of the Permit Application Packet that pertains to MB-5E (pages 2.05-34 and -35) and update as necessary.

It will also be necessary to update the reclamation cost estimate with TR-147; a proposed cost estimate will be generated when other adequacy items have been addressed.
