Pursuant to Rule 6.4.19, please submit a notarized letter from the utility company, on Xcel Energy letterhead, stating that the mining and reclamation activities, as proposed, will have "no negative effect" on their utility.

Please submit your response(s) to the above listed issue(s) by Friday, September 06, 2019 in order to allow the Division sufficient time for review.
