Re: Providence Mine Permit M-2012-052, 2018 Annual Fee, Report, and Map

Dear Mr. Cazier:

Newmont Goldcorp Mining Corporation hereby submits the annual report form, map, and annual fee of \$518 for the Cripple Creek & Victor Gold Mining Company (CC&V) Providence Mine Permit M-2012-052. This report covers the 2018-2019 reporting period.

On January 23, 2019, the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (the Division) and the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board approved CC&V's Notice of Temporary Cessation of the Providence Mine. The period of temporary cessation is effective July 5, 2018 through July 5, 2023.

In July 2018, the Division conducted a routine inspection of the Providence Mine. In response to issues identified during that inspection, the following actions were completed by November 2018:

- 1. Erosion repair and improved sediment control (Photo 1-6).
- 2. Air raise boreholes secured to preclude access (Photos 7-10).
- 3. Noxious weed control continued implementation (on-going).
- 4. Removal of existing waste rock stockpile, as directed by the Division (Photos 11-14).

In August of 2019, the Division conducted a routine inspection of the Providence Mine. Improvements were made to areas based on discussion during that inspection, including:

- 1. Installation of new signage (Photo 15).
- 2. Removal of stored waste rock and super-sack (photos 16-17).

Stipulation No. 1 of the issued permit requires CC&V to perform annual testing of all ore and waste rock brought to land surface. No ore or waste rock was produced during the



2018-2019 reporting period at this location; therefore, no geochemical test results are enclosed with the annual report.
